

## **Android Setup Instructions**

- 1. Change your Iridium AxcessPoint Outbound Filter
  - Turn ON Iridium AxcessPoint.
  - Connect to Iridium AxcessPoint to your Wi-Fi laptop via the WiFi connection.
  - Open a web browser and connect to Iridium AxcessPoint's IP address: htttp://192.168.0.1. This will bring you to the Administrative Page.
  - Enter your Iridium AxcessPoint's password which is the last 6 digits of the MAC address (can be found on the back of the device).
  - Go to the Advanced tab.
  - Select Outbound Filter along the left hand navigation.
  - In Global Filters Settings, uncheck <enable>.
  - Save settings.
- 2. Download and install Firefox Mobile for your Android device.
  - Go to http://www.mozilla.org/en-US/mobile/
- 3. Configure your Firefox Mobile browser for Iridium AxcessPoint Mail & Web
  - Type "about:config" in the address bar and press return.
  - Type "proxy.http" in the search box.
  - Enter the following information.
  - Network.proxy.htttp: web.myiridium.net.
  - Network.proxy.port: 3119.
  - Enter "type" into the search box.
  - Network.proxy.type: 1.
  - Click "Save".
- 4. Login to Iridium AxcessPoint Mail & Web with your Android's Firefox browser
  - Open Firefox, enter any URL.
  - Enter username and password provided for Iridium AxcessPoint Mail & Web.
- 5. Set-up and use your Android device for Web browsing with your Iridium satellite phone and AxcessPoint accessory
  - Connect your Iridium AxcessPoint to your Iridium satellite phone with the provided USB cable.
  - Turn on both devices in an open, outdoor area and wait for all three lights on the Iridium AxcessPoint device to turn green.
  - Click on your Android Menu button.
  - Select Settings.
  - Select Wireless & Networks.
  - Turn on Wi-Fi.
  - Select PHS300IC-xxx under Wi-Fi Networks.
  - Use Firefox when browsing with Iridium AxcessPoint Mail & Web for up to 5x faster effective speeds and browse mobile websites for faster downloads. Bookmark www.iridium.com/mobile for a list of mobile websites
  - When browsing on your cellular network, use another browser to avoid having to change the settings back to default.
